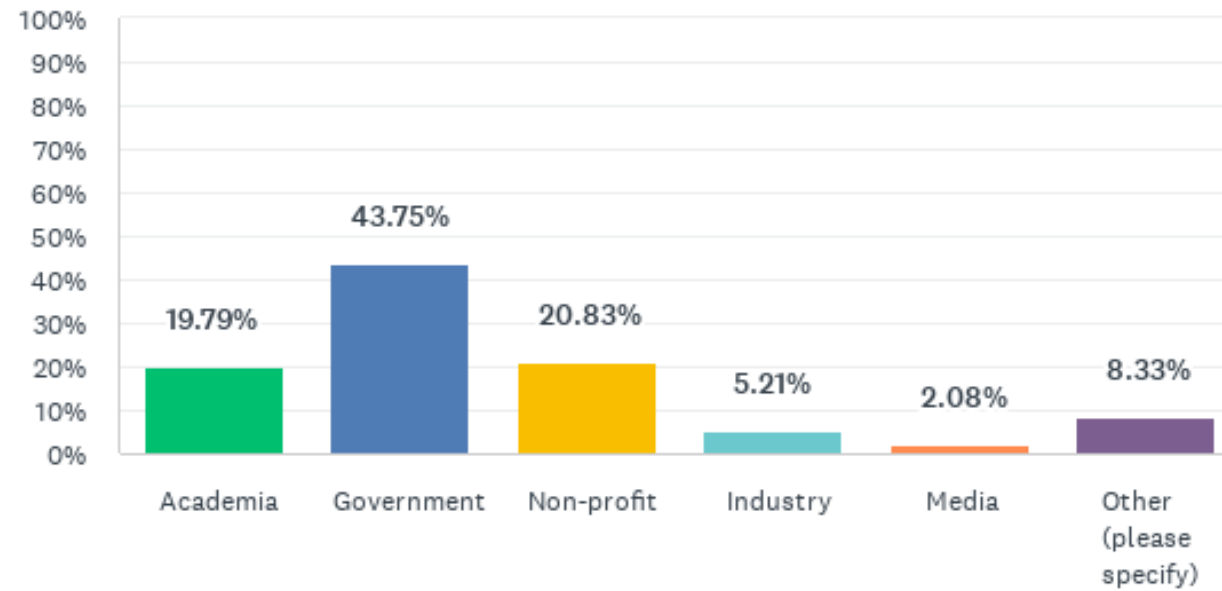

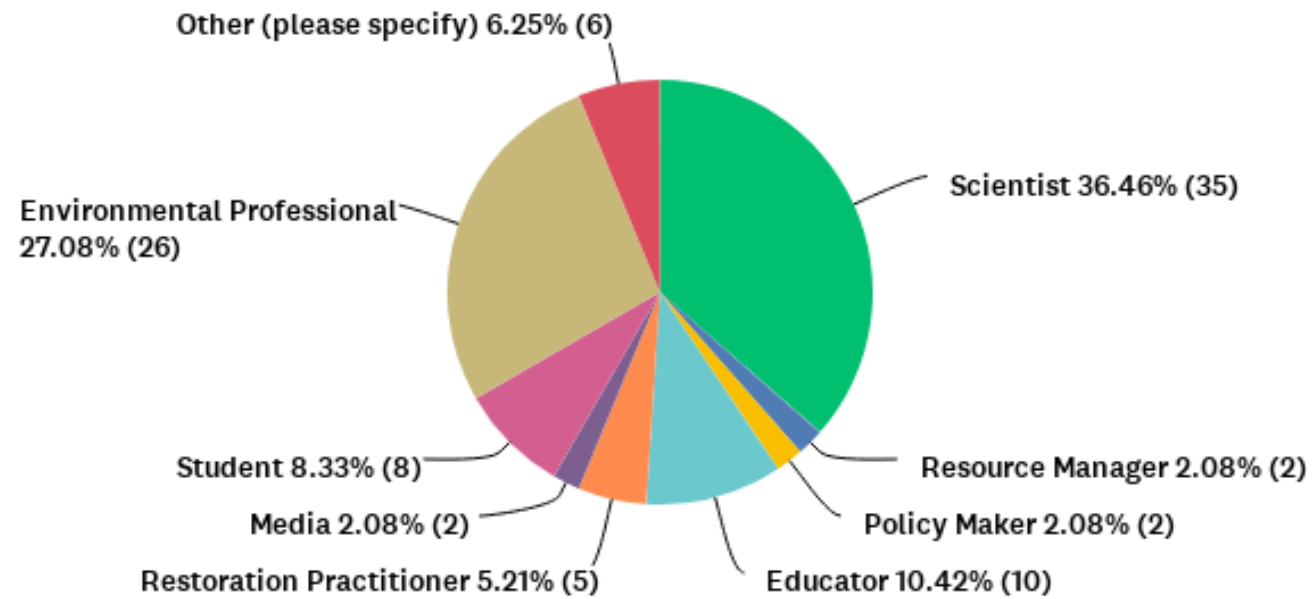

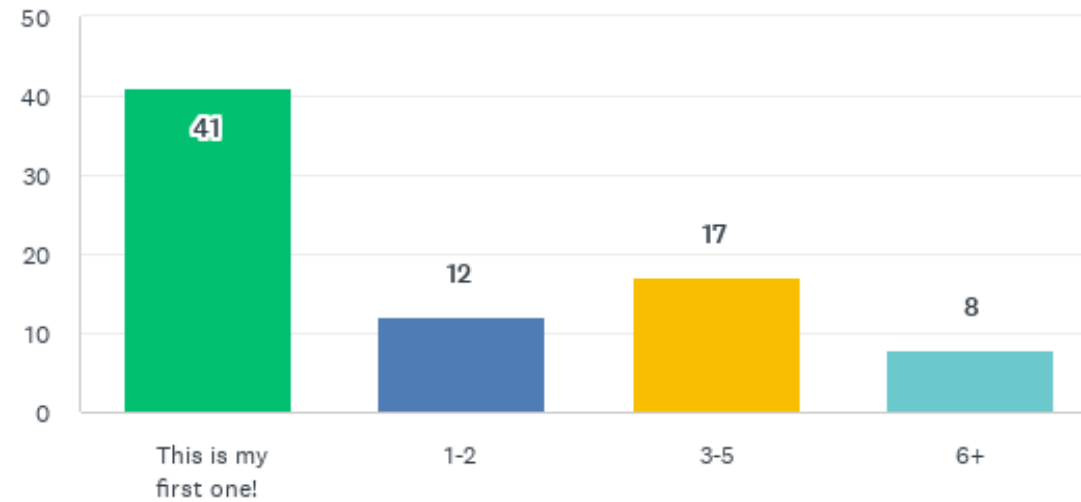
Q1 What sector do you represent?



Q2 Which of the following best describes you?

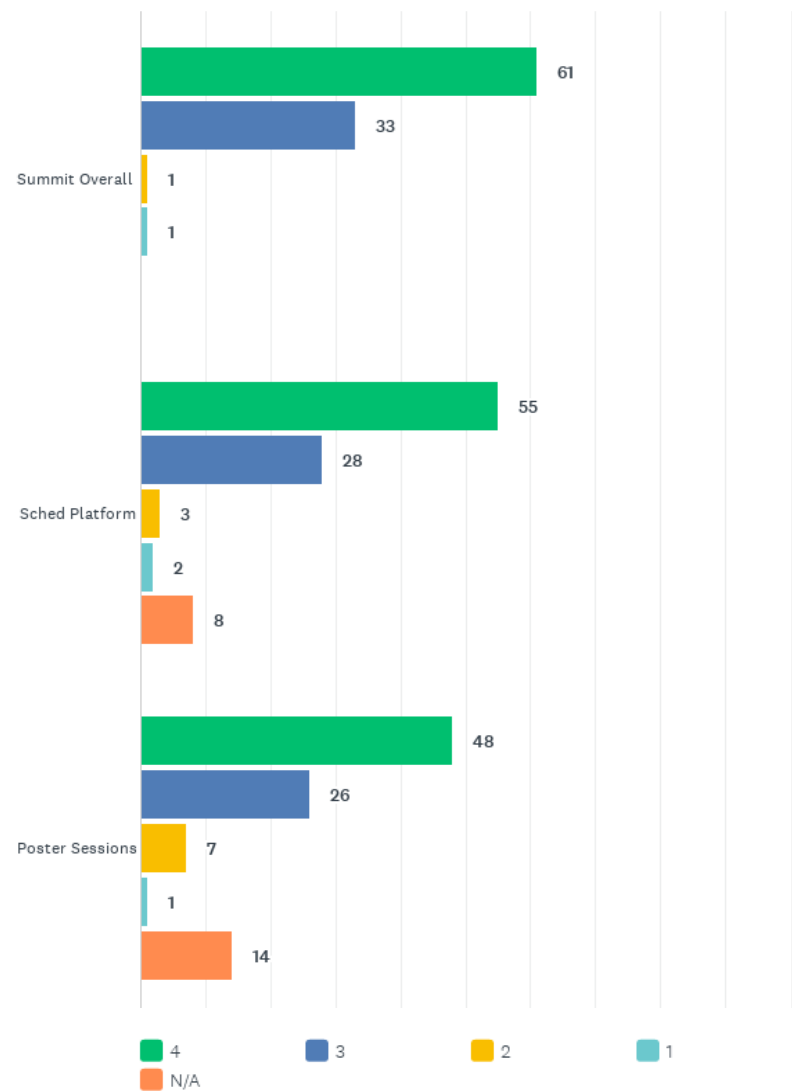


Q3 How many IN PERSON summits have you been to?

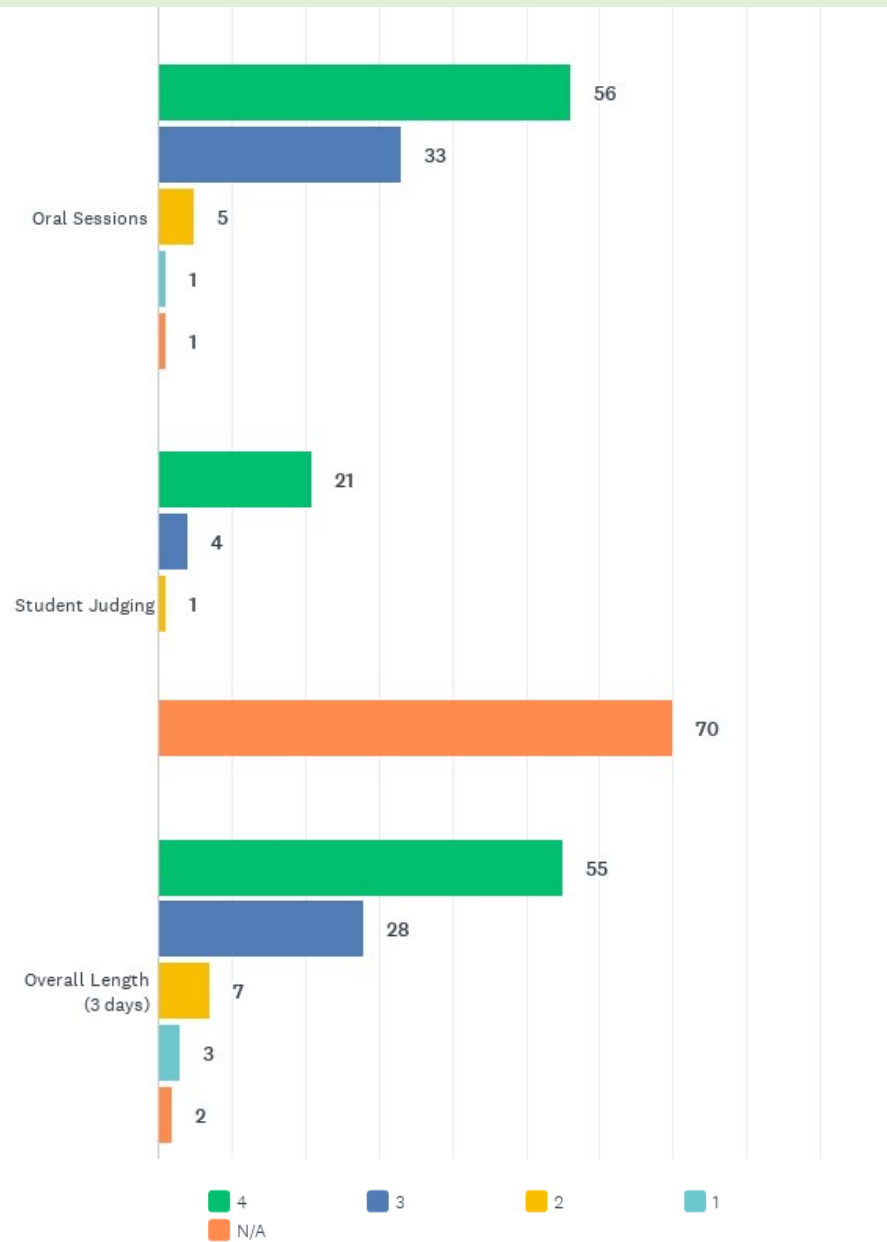

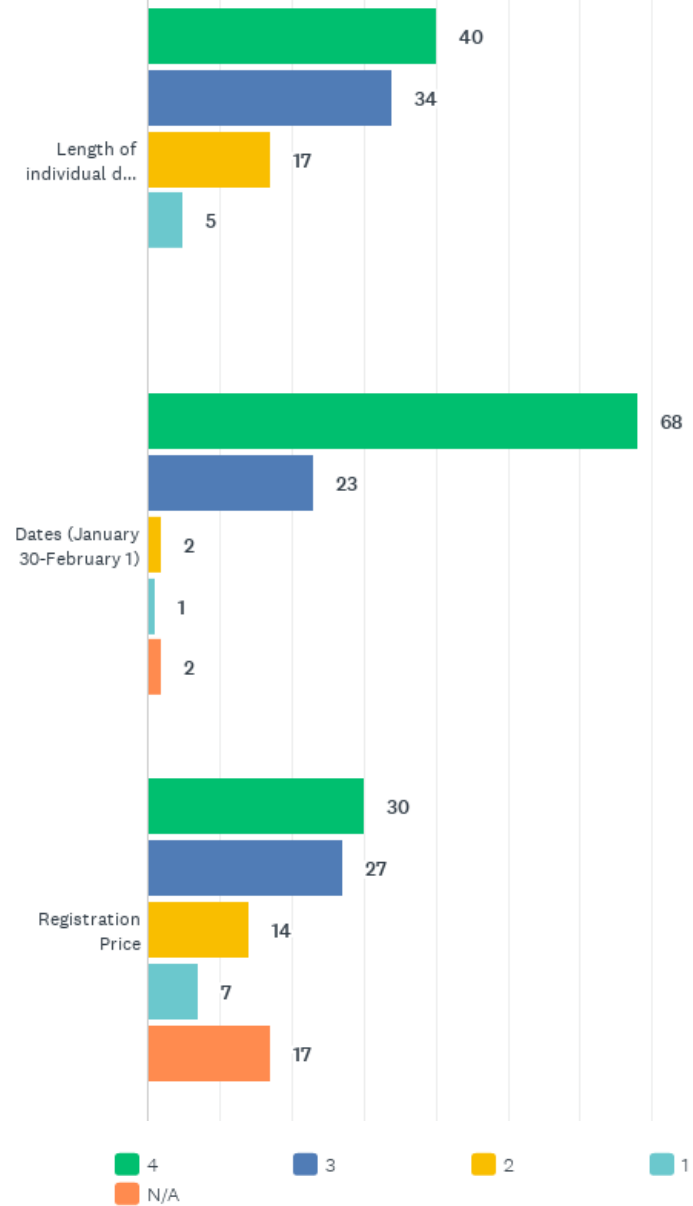
Q4 What did you think of the (1-very unsatisfied, 4-excellent):



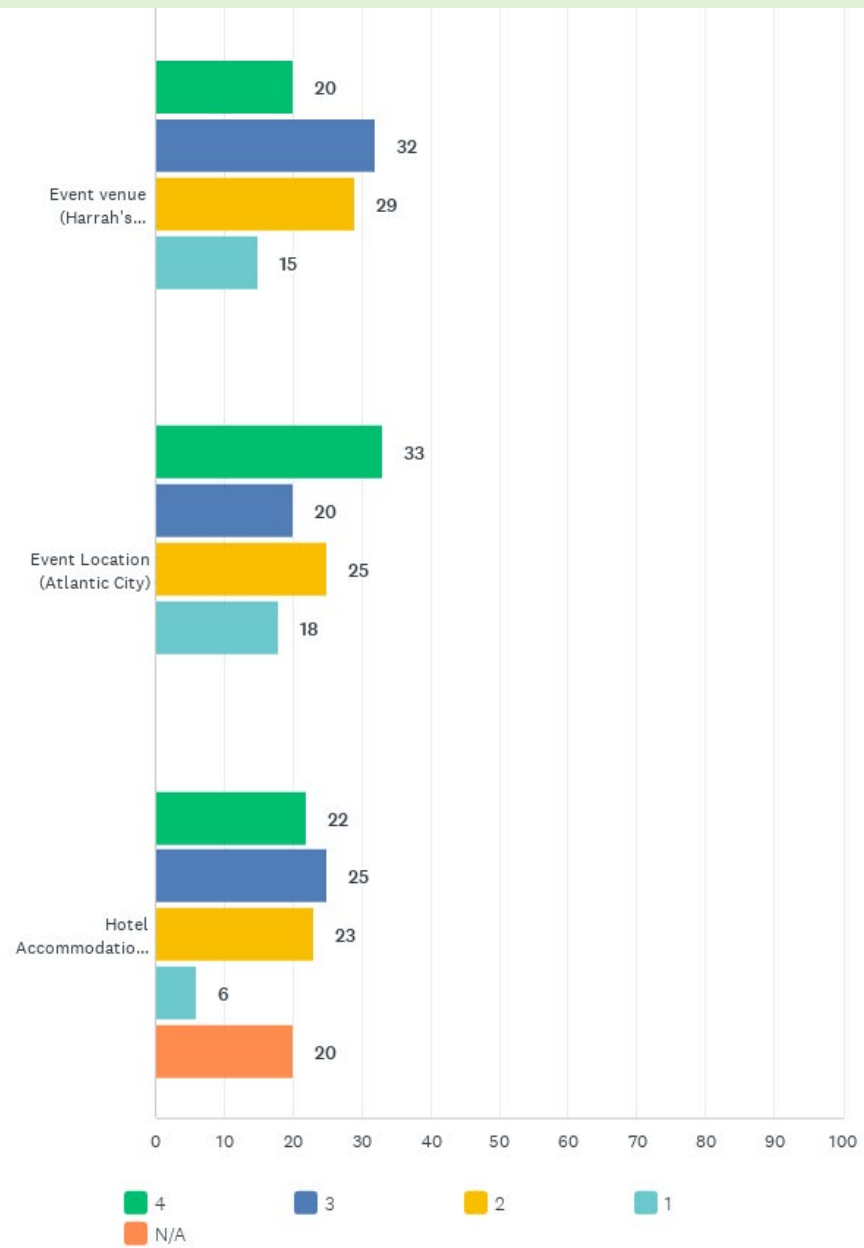


