



Urban Waters Delaware River Location:

Supplemental Community Funding Guidelines

Introduction

The Partnership for the Delaware Estuary (PDE) is happy to offer supportive funding to projects that fall within the <u>mission and guiding principles of the Urban Waters Federal Partnership (UWFP)</u> in the Delaware River Location. Eligible organizations can request up to \$1,500 for supplies to supplement projects, programs, or events. At least two projects will be funded per each of the four cities listed below, available on a rolling basis until December 31, 2022 or until funds are completely allocated.

Eligible regions:

Eligible projects should fall within the city limits of the four UWFP <u>Delaware River Location</u> cities: **Camden, NJ; Chester, PA; Philadelphia, PA; or Wilmington, DE**. Priority will be given to projects and programs located in an identified environmental justice area and that directly involve community members and/or students.

Eligible organizations:

- Nonprofit organizations, registered with the IRS as a 501(c)3
- Academic institutions (public or private)
- Municipal agencies and community development corporations
- Tribal nations

Eligible projects:

The following types of projects, programs, and events are eligible for funding support under this program:

- Green stormwater infrastructure (rain gardens, bioswales, etc.)
- Pollinator gardens and corridors
- Community gardens
- Tree plantings

- Improving urban trails and waterfronts
- Living shorelines or other climate resilience projects
- Events and programs that connect communities with nature/waterfronts

If you aren't sure if your project aligns with any of the types listed above, contact the Urban Waters Ambassador to discuss your project's eligibility.

Ineligible costs:

The following types of costs are not eligible for funding support under this program:

- Lobbying costs
- Non-federal match costs
