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

BRIC—Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities


- Annual competitive mitigation program

- Issued by FEMA's Federal Insurance & Mitigation Administration (FIMA)

- 6. Leveraging Partners




Mid-Atlantic Grantees: BRIC Year One




