

PDE Science and **Education Outreach** departments collaboratively train volunteers to survey streams for freshwater mussels, an important component in the FMRP that will help restore mussel populations in **Delaware Estuary** waterways.

Program Features:

- Classroom instruction from PDE science and outreach staff.
- Hands-on, in-stream mussel survey training.
- Freshwater Mussels of the Delaware Estuary ID Guide & Volunteer Survey Guidebook
- Online portal for volunteers to upload data for scientific analyses and follow-up.
- Online tracking map for volunteers to see where others have surveyed.
- 2012-2014 = 233 Volunteers trained!
